POINT TO PONDER

Last week, we read about Avrohom Avinu and how he almost lost his son at the Akeida, the son who was supposed to carry on his glorious tradition. When he returns, he finds that his life partner, Sarah, has passed away. After the burial and eulogies, Avrohom knows what he must do: *vayomer Avrohom el avdo--*he turns to his trusted steward Eliezer, and sends him on a mission to find a wife for his son.

Avrohom realizes that first and foremost, he must secure the future. The traumatic experiences he has been through teach him that when something happens, first of all he must guarantee his future, then he can attend to details.

This week we mark the *shloshim* of the terrible tragedy of October 7. Many people are asking--how could Hamas break in? Where was the security? What happened to the intelligence service? These are all valid questions--<u>for tomorrow</u>, not <u>for now</u>. Now, job one, the only job, is to retrieve the hostages and destroy Hamas, so that this will not happen again. What we should be doing now is saying tehillim, praying for soldiers and hostages, trying to do more mitzvot, more chesed, send packages, helmets, more positive thinking about fellow Jews.

Later, we need to consider what we have seen and learned in these dreadful times. As an example, when we see what is going on at elite universities, maybe we should rethink whether we really want to expose our precious children to such a devilish environment. Later, Israel will have to review its security procedures and make necessary adjustments. But that's for tomorrow. Today, we need to secure our future by confronting the crisis of today and beseeching Hashem to be with our soldiers and our people. We pray that He hears our cries.


