## WHEN GETTING THE COVID VACCINE

now that the covid vaccine is hopefully becoming more available to many, we need to be aware of a teaching in the Shulchan Aruch 230:4:

someone who is going [to have a medical procedure], before the procedure should say the following:

יהי רצון מלפניך ד' אל-קי שיהא עסק זה לי לרפואה כי רופא

חנם אתה

"May it be your will, Hashem my G-d, that this procedure will heal me, because You are the Free Healer."

And after the procedure, one should say the following: שברוך רופא חולים—Blessed is the One Who heals the sick
